- The suggested study aims to create an efficient dynamic routing strategy for wide-area networks. In order to accomplish effective routing, clustering and cluster head selection are formed using cascaded ANN.
- In proposed system, clustering and routing mechanism are employed to resolve these issues. The novel clustering algorithm based on Cascaded Artificial Neural Network and routing path selection uses hydridized Ant Colony Optimization (ACO), and Salp Swarm Optimization (SSO) is proposed to support massive mobile ad hoc networks.
- To examine the proposed system, MATLAB software is used to run simulations.
- According to the simulation results, the MANET network performance factors such as throughput, Packet delivery ratio, delay, and Average energy have improved.
